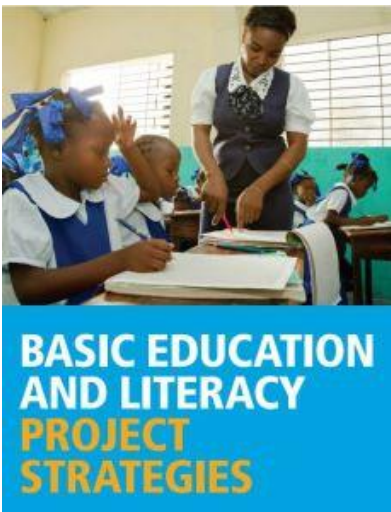

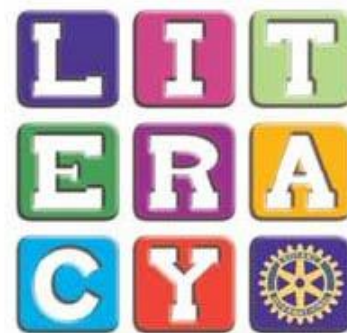
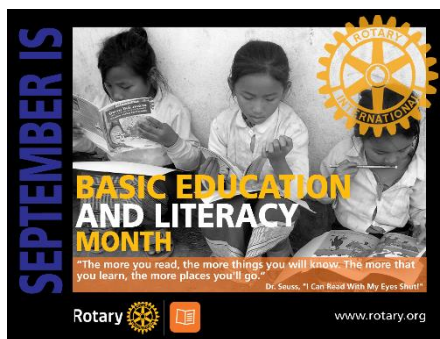
It's a fabulous community building event.
